Ms. Cherry, pursued her passion for teaching children of all ages from the time she was a teenager herself. Her formal musical education began at age fourteen when her mother and aunts began a family Bible class that was held every Saturday evening. Among their gathering was Mr. Walter Owens, he served as the musician and taught Cherry how to play gospel music and teach vocal parts. At the age of 15, Cherry was blessed by the congregation at Faith Lutheran Church where she served as musician and was sent to the Conservatory of Music at Roosevelt University in Chicago, IL for private music lessons and additional vocal training. She has also received additional formal

education at Concordia Teacher's College for music and education. Over the course of her musical career Cherry has had the opportunity to be mentored by great musicians. Among her many teaching positions Cherry taught at Mt. Calvary Christian Academy and Emmanuel Christian Academy for music and art, and implemented music programs at several daycares on the South Side of Chicago. She joined the Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church in 1981 and immediately was hired by the Pastor Rev. Clay Evans and Minister of Music, Mrs. Lou Della Evans-Reid for the children's music ministry of 250 choir members eventually leading to the youth choir.

IL, Bishop Larry D. Trotter Senior Pastor. One of her greatest accomplishments was coordinating the Youth Arc Choir, under the direction of Rev. Clay Evans and

Rev. Charles Jenkins, now known as Joshua's Troop, a Stellar Award winning recording choir in 2010.

She trained a staff of youth to coordinate, and walked the pavement to find choir members of all denominations. Cherry's work has always involved the youth and given her the foundation for her God given assignment. Cherry's favorite summer program was VBS. Now a proud representative.

When the charge from President Barack Obama to perform community service came, she realized her new calling to help homeless teens and travel around world to inspire. Cherry has also been inspired by Oprah Winfrey's commitment to helping youth attend college and build schools. Today, Cherry is the CEO of the Ascended Life Outreach for Teens (A.L.O.T.), an organization committed to providing warm meals, meeting their immediate needs and sources for homeless teens of Chicago, Indiana and Las Vegas NV.
